Benefits of Bilingualism

Establishing an extracurricular language program opens students to the seemingly endless benefits of bilingualism.

Language learning in schools is proven to boost overall literacy, which is a major predictor of children's attainment in maths and science. It has also been proven that the ability to switch between languages develops cognitive flexibility and improves multitasking and creativity.

Research in fact suggests that bilingual students have greater school achievement rates than monolingual children. Beyond academic success, bilinguals have notably more acute skills in perspective taking, perceiving and dealing with conflict cues, and ignoring irrelevant information.

A common worry is that learning another language may be too taxing or strenuous for a child. Rest assured, there is no cause for concern – our brains are programmed to learn and understand multiple languages! Research shows that young brains are not only able to cope with more than one language, but are actually the most receptive to language instruction.

But the benefits don't stop there. In adulthood, bilingualism opens doors to trade, business, diplomacy, the economy, travel and the people and cultures of the world. And in old age, the increased connectivity in certain areas of the brain created by bilingualism works to slows the onset of dementia and Alzheimer's.

All signs point towards the benefits of learning a language.

Instruction Our immersion pedagogy is to use French as much as possible in the classroom, using gestures and mimes to assist understanding.

LESSON 1:

Establishing classroom routines, including welcome song, personal introductions, talking about moods to make students feel welcome and comfortable.

LESSON 1 & 2:

Revision of colours and numbers while introducing shapes, reinforced and committed to memory through games.

LESSON 3:

In-depth study of traditional children's storybooks such as *Goldilocks and the Three Bears*. Extraction of key vocabulary related to the French family environment.

LESSON 4:

Adjectives used to describe physical appearence, taken from the indepth book study. Craft activity to reinforce these adjectives.

LESSON 5:


Application of adjectival agreement to vocabulary of physical appearence to describe family members.

LESSON 6 & 7:

Introduction of vocabulary and linguistic structures around members of the family. Made more complex by incorporating numbers and structures for talking about ages.

LESSON 8-9:

Fathers' Day/Parent's Day craft. Students learn vocabulary for the material required to make a card as well as associated action verbs.
