Project Structure

One A3 sheet with your name written in \$15 per submission (before 7 June) the bottom right-hand corner

On a separate sheet of paper, a short paragraph (100 words max) explaining • what France and learning French mean to you

Important Information

- \$20 per submission (from 8 June)
- Individual or group (of no more than 5) submissions
- Competition categories are: Yrs 5-6 (Stage 3); Yrs 7-8 (Stage 4)
- PNG format for photo collage
- · PDF format for short paragraph

What next?

1. Registration

Order one "Option Photo" from the Alliance Française website per collage submitted.

Be sure to keep your receipt - your invoice number will become your registration number!

2. Creation

What do you think of when you think of France? Why do you learn French? Why is it attractive to you? What does it mean to you?

Capture these elements in photos, and combine into an A3 photo collage.

See if a fresh set of eyes can identify they key elements.

3. Submission
